



Country Strategy Swaziland

Our work in Swaziland is characterized by the multiple partner setup.

The main objectives of Kindernothilfe's work in Swaziland are the fight against poverty, the care for OVCs (Orphans and Vulnerable Children), the support of young women and the propagation of child rights.

Further promotion of the SHG (Self Help Groups) approach and the continuation of community development programs are important instruments in fighting poverty and ensuring an adequate food supply. These measures ensure that people – particularly women – are in a position to earn a sufficient income and are able to provide adequate support for all the children and youth living under their roofs. Their children have enough food and can go to school. The women are also able to address and successfully tackle social concerns, both at household and community level, leading to sustainable improvement of the general household situation. The SHGs ensure that their OVCs receive adequate care.

The socially underprivileged – particularly young women – are trained at skills training centers. As a result, they have good prospects on the labor market - or can setup business on their own to support themselves.
